

Are Your Kids Ready for School?

Minnesota's School Immunization Law

Directions:

- Find the child's age/grade level and read across to the right.
- Look to see whether the child had the number of shots shown by the checkmark(s) under each vaccine.

Note: Each row is meant to be read separately, so don't add up the columns of checkmarks under each vaccine.

Example: A preschooler needs 4 DTaP, then to enter kindergarten he or she needs 1 more DTaP, for a total of 5 (not 9).

* Varicella shot(s) not required if a child's doctor signs a form saying the child has already had chickenpox disease.

** If a child received a Td at age 7-10 years they do not necessarily need another one at age 11-12. However, they must receive another shot of Td or Tdap 10 years after their last one.

*** An alternate 2-shot schedule of hepatitis B may also be used for kids from age 11 through 15 years.

**** The Hib requirement is temporarily suspended due to a vaccine shortage.

To go to school in Minnesota, students must show they've had these immunizations or file a legal exemption with the school.

Parents may file a medical exemption signed by a healthcare provider or a conscientious objection signed by a parent/guardian and notarized.

Other immunizations recommended for school kids, but not required by the School Immunization Law:

- Influenza (flu) – each year for children age 6 months through 18 years – especially those with risk factors like asthma and diabetes.
- Meningococcal for age 11-18.
- Human papillomavirus (HPV) for girls age 11-18.

No Shots, No School.



All Minneapolis Public School students must have immunizations up to date and the school must have the child's shot records for him or her to start school. Help your child be a healthy learner. If the child should not have shots for medical reasons or because of the beliefs of the parents, the school must have written proof of exemption.

Pab koj tus menyuam kom nws yog ib tug menyuam kawm ntawv tsis muaj mob hauv nws lub neej. Yog tias tus menyuam txhaj tsis tau tshuaj vim nws muab moj dab tsi los yog vim niam txiv tej kev ntseeg txwv tsis pub txhaj, lub tsev kawm ntawv yuav tsum tau ntaub ntawv pov thawj qhia tias tsis txhaj los tau.

Dhamaan ardayda Dugsiyada Dadweynaha ee Minneapolis waa inay qaateen tallaaladii looga baahnaa, waana in dugsi hayaa warbixinta tallaalka ilmaha si ardaygu u bilaabo dugsi. Ka caawi ilmahaaga inuu noqdo arday caafimaad qaba. Haddayna ahayn in la tallaalo ilmaha sababo caafimaad dartood ama waalidka oo sidaa rumaysan awood, iskuulku waa in uu haystaa qoraal caddeynaya arrintaas.

Si su niño no está vacunado, no puede asistir a la escuela

Todos los alumnos de las Escuelas Públicas de Minneapolis deben tener sus vacunas actualizadas, y la escuela debe tener los registros de vacunación del niño o niña para que pueda asistir a la escuela. Ayude a su niño a ser un estudiante sano. Si el niño no puede recibir sus vacunas por razones médicas o por las creencias de los padres, la escuela debe tener un comprobante de exención por escrito.
